Effective January 1, 2010**

**BERTHAGE**

Six dollars (\$6.18) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

- (A) When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be Seventy-five cents (\$0.77) per meter per hour or part thereof.
- (B) On all days defined as non-working days in the Agreement in force between the International Longshoremen and Warehousemen's Union and the British Columbia Maritime Employers Association, the rate shall be Three Dollar (\$3.09) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or fraction thereof, except that when any portion of an eight (8) hour period occurring either before or at the end of one or more eight hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for such fraction shall be Thirty-seven cents (\$0.38) per meter per hour or part thereof.

**GANGWAY**

One Hundred and fifty-five dollars and forty cents (\$170.94) for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be nineteen dollars and forty-three cents (\$21.37) per hour or part thereof.

**FRESH WATER**

\$3.09 (three dollars and nine cents) per 1,000 (one thousand) kilos.

Hose connections: \$130.00 (one hundred and thirty dollars)  
per connection. Includes 100 ft. hose.

Each additional 50 ft. length of hose  
\$26.50 (twenty six dollars and fifty cents )
